THE SECOND COLLECTION this week is for the Archdiocesan Curia & Cathedral Pastoral Centre Operations & Maintenance Fund.


THE SALE OF TODAY'S CATHOLIC will take place this weekend at the church entrances. They are selling at cost (i.e. only RM2.50 per copy). We urge every family to get a copy to support this worthy effort of the Archdiocesan Social Communications Committee.

<u>PALM SUNDAY</u> falls on 13<sup>th</sup> April this year. There will be blessing of palms at every Mass on Palm Sunday and a procession at the beginning of the BM Mass in the Cathedral. "Perjalanan SALIB" with a special cross blessed for public veneration throughout the Archdiocese of Kuching, will begin its pilgrimage in this procession.

Parishioners who wish to participate in the procession at the Cathedral are requested to assemble at St. Peter's College ground for the blessing of palms at 11:00 am sharp. To facilitate the procession, motorists coming for the Mandarin and BM Mass are kindly requested **NOT** to park along the road from the Guard house to the Seminary. Please follow the directives of our Security & RELA personnel.

PARISHIONERS ARE REMINDED TO **BRING YOUR OWN PALM LEAVES** FROM HOME FOR THE PALM SUNDAY SERVICE. If you have any extra palms, do bring them and pass to the Ushers on duty at the Church entrances for other parishioners in need.

<u>LENTEN CONFESSION</u> specifically for the elderly and their accompanying caregivers will be held on Monday, 14th April from 8:30 am till 10:00 am at the Cathedral.

<u>CHRISM MASS</u> (in English) will be celebrated in the Cathedral on Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> April at 7:30 pm. There will be no daily Mass at 5:30 pm that evening. During this Mass, our Archbishops and all Priests of the Archdiocese of Kuching will come together to publicly renew their priestly commitment. All Parishioners are encouraged to come and support them with our prayers.

#### DROP-OFFS AND SEATS FOR THE ELDERLY & PEOPLE WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

During the Holy Week, arrangements will be made to facilitate access for elderly, physically challenged (disabled) and their accompanying caregivers. Drop-offs are directed to left of the main entrance and at the Day Chapel entrance. Designated seating, available on a first-come, first-served basis, is located in the Day Chapel and the old Choir wing. These seats are not to be reserved but will be occupied on a first-come-first-serve basis. We appeal for your kind understanding and co-operation to respect those with special needs.

<u>PARKING OF VEHICLES</u> (throughout Holy Week and Easter Triduum services) - The limited parking lots in front of the Cathedral are for cars ferrying elderly passengers, particularly those with special needs and walking difficulty. Likewise, parking lots in front of the Day Chapel are also for vehicles ferrying physically challenged (disabled) passengers.

To mitigate parking constraint in the Cathedral compound, parishioners are encouraged to **CAR-POOL** to church throughout the Holy Week, i.e. from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday; and park your vehicles at the car park beside St. Joseph's Kindergarten (formerly St. Jude's Kindergarten), at St. Joseph's or St. Teresa's school car parks or elsewhere. Please follow the directives of our Security team and RELA personnel.

We appeal to all parishioners to park properly and refrain from obstructing traffic flow or other vehicles. Please DO NOT leave any valuable items or bags visibly in your cars. There will be **NO ANNOUNCEMENT** of car plate numbers throughout the Easter Triduum services. After Mass, the back gate next to the Sarawak Club will be opened for cars to exit the Cathedral compound.

<u>APPEAL FOR FRESH FLOWERS</u> - Parishioners are requested to donate fresh flowers particularly, **WHITE ROSE** & **WHITE ORCHID** for our Easter decorations of the Sanctuary. Please deliver them to the Cathedral Sacristy on **Good Friday**, 18th April before 10:00 am.

- Please arrive early and be seated at least 10 minutes before Mass begins to avoid causing unnecessary interruption or distraction.
- The sacredness of the Eucharistic celebration urges all participants to dress appropriately when entering the Church for Holy Mass and manifest the importance of what we are doing as a worshipping community.
- Wearing of face masks in Church is no longer mandatory but highly encouraged, especially in crowded and closed environment.
- Those sick with flu-like symptoms (e.g. fever, cough, runny nose, etc.) are to exercise prudence and refrain from joining the congregation in Church.
